

>> LESSONS LEARNED

- Support across stages is essential. Pakistan's Femtech ecosystem is nascent and requires both earlyand late-stage pathways.
- Financing gaps hold back growth. Many founders self-subsidize through side jobs; dedicated financing channels are urgently needed.
- Piloting is hard. Structured access to real beneficiaries, particularly in rural and peri-urban communities, is missing.
- Regulation is a bottleneck. Startups lack the expertise to navigate complex health-tech approval processes.
- Research linkages must be strengthened. Tighter connections to clinical and academic research will improve design, validation, and scale.
